

**Proposed change to Mulberry School Bylaws (highlighted in red):**

**Section 3.7 Term of Trustees.** The initial term of a Voting Trustee is one (1) year. At the end of a Voting Trustee's one-year term, the Board may elect the Voting Trustee for a term of up to an additional two (2) years. Upon expiration of the initial three years of service, the Board may elect the Voting Trustee to serve an additional term of up to three (3) years. After at least one year of absence from the Board, such Voting Trustee may be elected to serve an additional three (3) years. **After an additional one year of absence, the Board may elect the Voting Trustee to a final three years, for a total of 12 years of Board service. If the Board decides there are extraordinary circumstances that require the Voting Trustee to continue serving for the good of the school, the Board may vote to waive one or both of the one-year periods of absence.**
